- THE WARRANTY.

 DO NOT EXPOSE THE BALLAST TO WATER.
- OPERATE THE UNIT INDOORS ONLY.

- INSTALLATION
- 1. Position the Ballast using one of the following options:
 - A. MOUNT THE BALLAST BY THE BASE IN A STABLE LOCATION. USE HEAVY-DUTY SCREWS (NOT INCLUDED) THAT CAN SUPPORT THE WEIGHT OF THE BALLAST.
 - B. PLACE THE BALLAST ON A FLAT, STABLE SURFACE.
 - C. SUSPEND THE BALLAST FROM AN ADEQUATE SUPPORT BY THE HANGING TABS. IF DESIRED, ATTACH TO A COMPATIBLE REFLECTOR* FEATURING A BALLAST MOUNT.
- 2. CONNECT A LAMP CORD, WITH LAMP INSTALLED, TO THE BALLAST OUTPUT RECEPTACLE. (USE WITH A DOUBLE ENDED 1,000-WATT LAMP ONLY.)*
- 3. Plug the Ballast power cord into a power source of the appropriate voltage.
- *REFLECTOR, LAMP CORD AND LAMP SOLD SEPARATELY.

WATTAGE SETTINGS

USING THE VARIABLE WATTAGE DIAL, DIM THE BALLAST TO A LOWER WATTAGE SETTING FOR DECREASED LAMP OUTPUT, OR SET TO THE SUPER CHARGE SETTING TO BOOST LAMP OUTPUT. THE BALLAST'S SOFT DIMMING TECHNOLOGY WILL GRADUALLY ADJUST THE OUTPUT LEVEL. ALWAYS OPERATE THE LAMP AT FULL POWER FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO DIMMING.

LED STATUS INDICATORS

LOCATED ABOVE THE VARIABLE WATTAGE DIAL, THE GREEN LED INDICATORS ILLUMINATE TO IDENTIFY THE SELECTED WATTAGE SETTING. THE SELECTED LED WILL FLASH TO INDICATE THE BALLAST STATUS IF THE LAMP IS NOT IGNITED.

# OF FLASHES	STATUS	DESCRIPTION
1	BALLAST LOCKED	THE BALLAST MADE FIVE FAILED ATTEMPTS TO IGNITE THE LAMP. DISCONNECT THE BALLAST FROM THE POWER SOURCE, AND THEN RECONNECT IT.
2	CONNECTION LOCKED	AN UNEXPECTED ERROR OCCURRED, SUCH AS A SHORT OR OPEN CIRCUIT. ENSURE THE LAMP IS INTACT AND SECURELY SEATED IN THE SOCKET, AND ENSURE THE POWER AND LAMP CORDS ARE SECURELY CONNECTED TO THE BALLAST.
3	LOW INPUT VOLTAGE	THE VOLTAGE SUPPLIED TO THE BALLAST IS TOO LOW. ENSURE THE POWER SOURCE MATCHES THE POWER CORD VOLTAGE AND THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE BALLAST.
4	HIGH TEMPERATURE	THE BALLAST IS OVERHEATED. ENSURE THERE IS SUFFICIENT AIRFLOW AROUND THE BALLAST AND THE OPERATING ENVIRONMENT IS NOT EXCESSIVELY HOT.
5	HIGH INPUT VOLTAGE	THE VOLTAGE BEING SUPPLIED TO THE BALLAST IS TOO HIGH. ENSURE THE POWER SOURCE MATCHES THE POWER CORD VOLTAGE AND THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE BALLAST.
6	IGNITION BUSY	THE BALLAST IS ATTEMPTING TO IGNITE THE LAMP.
7	LAMP FAULT	THE LAMP RATINGS ARE NOT WITHIN THE REQUIRED RANGES. REPLACE THE LAMP WITH ONE HAVING THE CORRECT SPECIFICATIONS.



TROUBLESHOOTING

NOTE: REMEMBER TO ALWAYS DISCONNECT THE BALLAST FROM THE POWER SOURCE BEFORE SERVICING.

THE LAMP ISN'T IGNITING.

SEE THE LED STATUS INDICATORS SECTION ABOVE, SINCE THE BALLAST MAY BE DIAGNOSING THE PROBLEM OR ATTEMPTING TO IGNITE THE LAMP. CHECK THAT THE TIMER, CONTROLLER AND OUTLET ARE WORKING PROPERLY. IF THE OUTLET DOESN'T SEEM TO BE WORKING, CHECK THE CIRCUIT BREAKER. VERIFY ALL CABLE CONNECTIONS ARE SECURE AND THE RATED LAMP WATTAGE MATCHES THE BALLAST WATTAGE. USE THE BALLAST WITH A LAMP THAT IS CONFIRMED TO BE FUNCTIONING PROPERLY. IF THE LAMP STILL DOES NOT IGNITE, FOLLOW THE WARRANTY CLAIM STEPS. THIS BALLAST FEATURES END OF LAMP LIFE RECOGNITION, WHICH AUTOMATICALLY POWERS OFF THE BALLAST (FOR SAFETY AND BALLAST PROTECTION) WHEN LAMP DEGRADATION REACHES PRESET LIMITS. IF THIS FEATURE IS TRIGGERED, REPLACE THE LAMP TO RETURN THE BALLAST TO NORMAL OPERATION.

THE BALLAST STOPPED OPERATING.

EXCESSIVE TEMPERATURE, SHORT OR OPEN CIRCUITS, POWER SURGES AND OTHER CONDITIONS CAN TRIGGER INTEGRATED SAFETY FEATURES, RESULTING IN UNIT SHUTDOWN. SEE THE LED STATUS INDICATORS SECTION ABOVE, SINCE THE BALLAST MAY BE DIAGNOSING THE PROBLEM OR ATTEMPTING TO REIGNITE THE LAMP. UNPLUGGING THE BALLAST FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES, CHECKING AND RESETTING THE CIRCUIT BREAKER, AND/OR REDUCING THE NUMBER OF DEVICES CONNECTED TO THE CIRCUIT MAY ALSO RESOLVE THE PROBLEM. IF THE BALLAST STILL DOES NOT POWER ON AND/OR THE GREEN LED CONTINUES TO INDICATE AN ERROR, FOLLOW THE WARRANTY CLAIM STEPS.

What This Warranty Covers

This warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship under normal use, with any exceptions stated below.

Who This Warranty Covers

This warranty applies to the original purchaser of this ION® product with the original proof of purchase.

How Long Warranty Coverage Lasts

This warranty is in effect for a period of three years from the original date of purchase.

What This Warranty Does Not Cover

This warranty does not cover damage or defects resulting from the improper installation, alteration, abuse, accidental damage, unauthorized repair or misuse of this product. Misuse includes but is not limited to outdoor use. This warranty does not apply to cosmetic defects or other defects that do not affect the functionality of the product, and is void if the product has been damaged as a result of fire, flood, or other natural disaster.
